Tasting notes

Château Vieux Lavergne stands out for its richness and the elegance characteristic of the great wines of Bordeaux. In the glass, it appears dense and silky, adorned with a garnet hue of beautiful intensity. This wine offers a generous bouquet in which red fruits harmonize perfectly with spicy notes. Gourmet and well balanced, the finish reveals lingering aromas with all the finesse and charm of exceptional terroir.

This wine is superb, with a sensual profile that inspires pairings with refined dishes.

Ageing

An ageing period of 7 to 10 years laid out in darkened cellar. A period in which the flavors will further develop to charm the consumer's palate.

Serving

Serve between 14 and 16°C decanting 2 hours beforehand. It will pair wonderfully with sauced fish, as well as all grilled, roasted, stewed or sauced meats, cheeses, chocolate desserts...
